

A Sampling of Divine Laws and Principles

The Absolute dimension of Spirit is the unchangeable, infinite Divine Realm where Spiritual Laws guide and govern everything in the universe. This is where we reside as our purest, Spiritual Beingness.

However it is in the relative, ever-changing world of form and experience that makes up the majority of our awareness. It is where we express our Divine Beingness to the degree that we are aware of who we truly are. It is also where we see Spiritual Laws reflected. Our world is, in fact, a reflection of our individual and collective thoughts, feelings and actions. Like physical laws, such as the law of gravity, these laws are always at work whether we are aware of them or not. When we learn to work in harmony with these Spiritual Laws, we align ourselves with the flow of Divine Life and we allow more peace, love and prosperity to flow into our lives and into the world.

- 1. The Law of Mind Action.** Also called the “Law of Cause and Effect,” this basic Law says that whatever thoughts we think *repeatedly* will reflect into our physical experience. In the absolute realm, all possible ideas are available to us. We choose the ones that resonate best in the moment to our feelings and ideas. We then get to experience physically the ideas we have chosen. Most of humanity chooses unconsciously, but we can learn to choose consciously. We have the power to reject those ideas we don’t want to experience, and to choose or affirm those we prefer.
- 2. The Law of Attraction.** This is closely related to the Law of Mind Action. It says that every condition in our relative, physical lives was drawn to us by the energy we generate with our consistent thoughts and feelings. Another way to say this is, “what we focus on grows.”
- 3. The Law of Circulation.** According to this law, Giving and Receiving are equally important in establishing harmony and prosperity in our experience. Like breathing, we must release our breath in order to receive another. So too, with our love and our abundance Substance (Divine energy) must circulate. If it is blocked, it will not reach our experience. We can block our good at either end – either inflow or outflow (receiving or giving) with a similar result of deprivation.
- 4. Law of Infinite Expansion.** This law expresses the idea that all creation yearns for a greater and more expansive experience of good. The Universe is continually expanding and as expressions of Universal good, we too are meant to growth in consciousness and in our experience.
- 5. The Law of Asking and Receiving.** Because we have free will, the Universe does not force any good upon us until we realize we want it and we ask to receive it. As Emilie Cady said in her classic book, *Lessons in Truth*, “...*the instant we ask or desire (for asking is desire expressed) we touch a secret spring which starts on its way toward us the good we want.*”
